Please select from the options below, or call or text Matt Munhall, Director of Music and Liturgy, directly at 614.537.1933 for special requests as early as possible. He is relatively flexible and hopes to hear any of your requests that are not on the song list. However, there are church teachings **to which we must adhere** that ensure the celebration of the loved one's life is liturgically **appropriate**. Matt is open to working with soloists and/or singers requested by the family with a rehearsal fee depending on the situation. Matt plays both piano and organ and sings many different styles of music.

We are dedicated to making every effort to serve you in this time of grief, and help you create the most beautiful Liturgy possible for your beloved one, and all those attending. The lyrics to the songs will be shown on the screen above the altar. In addition, readings and prayer responses will be projected to the screen so that all present may actively participate in your loved one's funeral Mass.

Planning and attending a funeral Mass for a loved one is an emotional experience. When a family in that emotional state it is hard to focus on everything that is happening throughout the Mass. We provide the family with a YouTube internet address prior to the funeral so you can let other family members who may not be able to physically attend the funeral the opportunity to attend remotely. All the songs, readings and responses are preserved on a YouTube live-stream that anyone may access during or after the funeral. We will also provide one DVD copy of the funeral Mass to the family if they wish.

We, at St. Francis, are blessed to have professional quality cameras and sound equipment through which we live-stream our parish 11:00 am Sunday Mass and other events throughout the parish. All our videographers and technicians volunteer their time to provide this service to the parish family.

The live-stream multi-camera option funeral Mass allows our volunteer videographers and sound technicians to utilize our 3 cameras to capture the entirety of the Mass from different camera vantage points. This allows for close-up views of the different Mass parts. The live-streamed, one camera option allows our volunteer to utilize one wide view of the altar throughout the funeral. We may also be able to focus on the homilist so that his words are also captured in close-up. A donation of \$500.00 for the live-streamed multi-camera version is equally split between the fund to repair and upgrade the audio and video equipment and St. Francis de Sales School. There is no required donation for the one-camera and DVD version.
