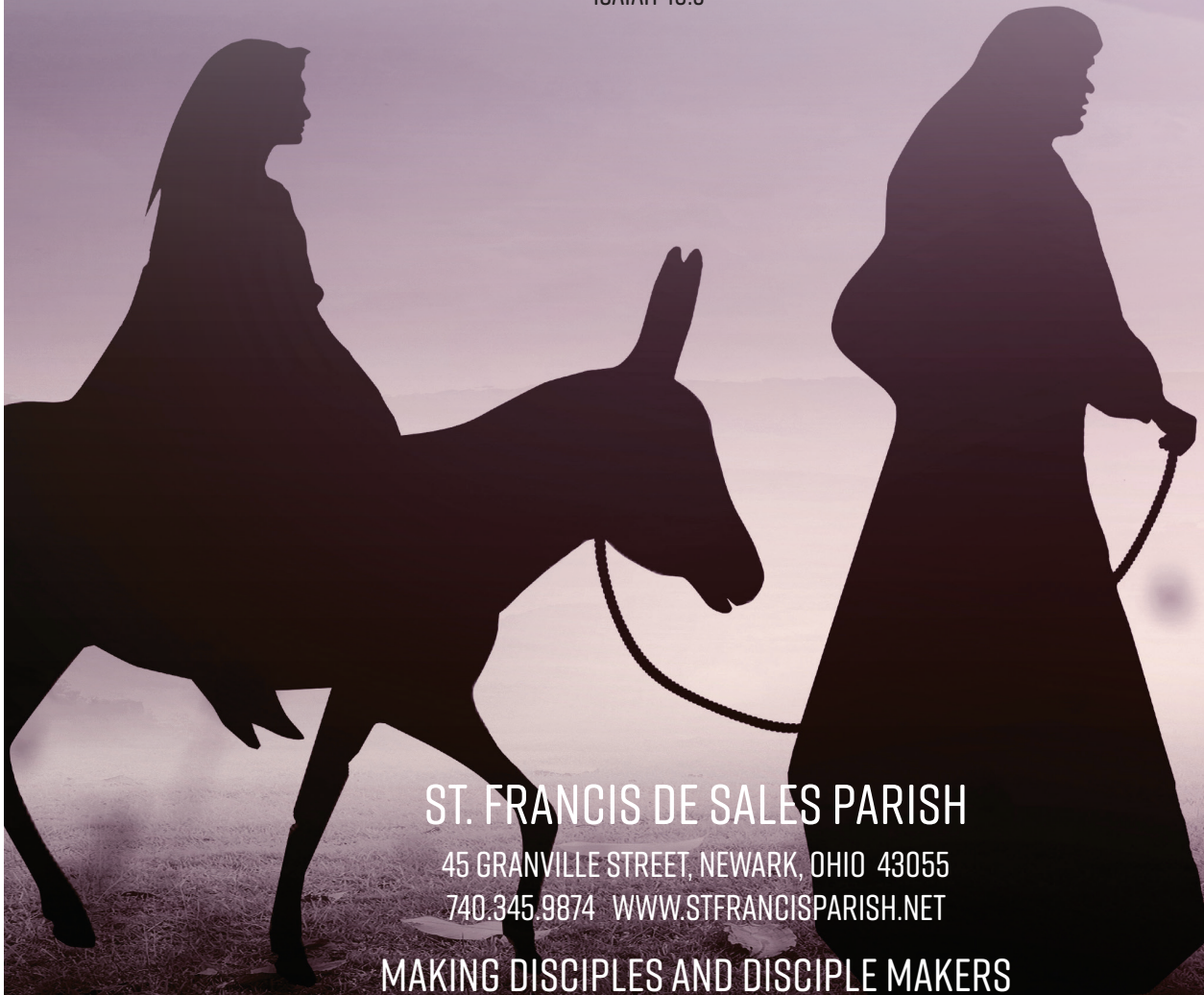

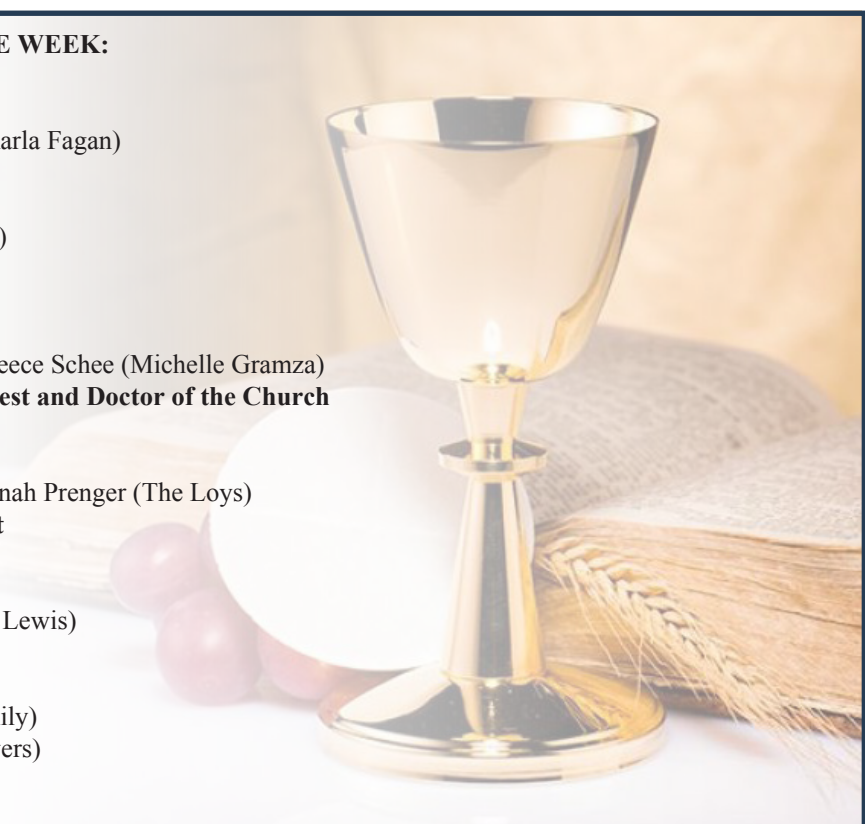

## THE LIGHT OF CHRIST

Reflection on John 1:6-8, 19-28

John, son of Zechariah and Elizabeth, was sent from God to testify to the light, to make straight the way of the Lord, to announce the coming of the Messiah. In this Gospel passage for this third Sunday of Advent, John makes a point to his interrogators that we might miss: The One he is proclaiming is already among them.

How did they not see Him? How can you miss the coming of One so powerful, so awaited, so desired? Indeed, how do we not see Him?

This spirit-filled Messiah is a reversal of what we normally esteem and look for in leaders. He will not dominate in the usual way we expect and even want – by military power, by financial might, by political influence, by the sheer weight of personal appeal and magnetism. Instead, His power will come from self-sacrificing love, and the world will be saved from death and darkness because of Him.

This is the light to which John testifies, and to which we bear witness, and by which we are transformed. Will you join the holy conspiracy of the incarnation, and shine with the very light of God, and breathe with the very Spirit of God?

## SAINT PETER CANISIUS

*Feast Day: December 21*

*Patron Saint of: Germany*

Although Peter once accused himself of idleness in his youth, he could not have been idle too long, for at the age of 19, he received a master's degree from the university at Cologne. At this early age, Peter had already taken up a practice he continued throughout his life – a process of study, reflection, prayer, and writing. After his ordination in 1546, he became widely known for his editions of the writings of St. Cyril of Alexandria and St. Leo the Great. Besides this reflective literary bent, Peter had a zeal for the apostolate. He could often be found visiting the sick or imprisoned, even when his assigned duties in other areas were more than enough to keep most people fully occupied.

In 1547, Peter attended several sessions of the Council of Trent, whose decrees he was later assigned to implement. After a brief teaching assignment at the Jesuit college at Messina, Peter was entrusted with the mission to Germany – from that point on, his life's work. He taught in several universities and was instrumental in establishing many colleges and seminaries. He wrote a catechism that explained the Catholic faith in a way that common people could understand.

Renowned as a popular preacher, Peter packed churches with those eager to hear his eloquent proclamation of the Gospel. He had great diplomatic ability, often serving as a reconciler between disputing factions. In his letters – filling eight volumes – one finds words of wisdom and counsel to people in all walks of life. At times he wrote unprecedented letters of criticism to leaders of the Church – yet always in the context of a loving, sympathetic concern.

At 70, Peter suffered a paralytic seizure, but he continued to preach and write with the aid of a secretary, until his death in his hometown of Nijmegen, Netherlands, on December 21, 1597.

## EMMAUS ROAD SCHOLARSHIP FUND

In 2021, the State of Ohio created a Scholarship Granting Organization (SGO) Program. This program allows Ohio taxpayers to donate to a K-12 SGO for that school to use for scholarships for tuition based on financial need. The donor then receives a dollar-for-dollar non-refundable tax credit on their Ohio state tax return up to \$750 (\$1,500 if married and filing jointly). This is in addition to a federal tax deduction you are always able to take.

All donations will be managed through the Emmaus Road Scholarship Fund. Parishioners, family, and friends of St. Francis de Sales can donate and **directly designate St. Francis School as the recipient of their donation.** If you choose not to designate a school, the money will be used in a general fund for financial aid for diocesan students based on need. 100% of those funds will be available to our school the following tax year to be used for scholarships for our students.

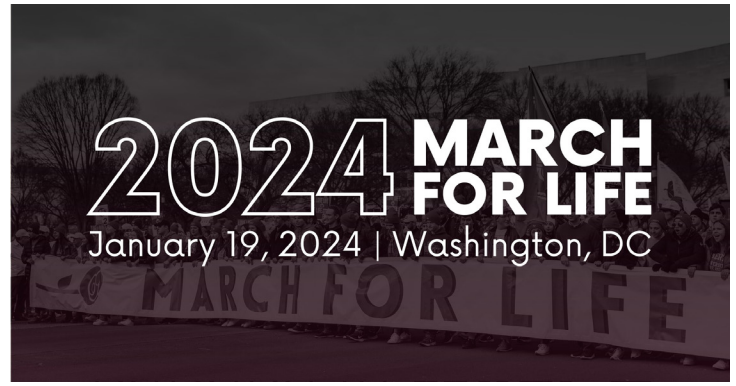

### A NOTE FROM THE COLUMBUS DIOCESE

Over a year ago, a discussion began regarding a potential merger between the dioceses of Columbus and Steubenville. That discussion was tabled for a time. Fast forward to now, the Apostolic Nunciature has asked Bishop Fernandes and Bishop Bradley (Apostolic Administrator of Steubenville) to lead their respective diocesan leadership teams to coalesce data to be presented to the Holy Father, in order that he may discern a path forward.

Last week, leadership from both dioceses met to begin that work. The final decision will come from the Holy Father; however, at this time, no decision has been made. A joint statement between the dioceses of Columbus and Steubenville has been released publicly and can be found on the St. Francis Parish website.
